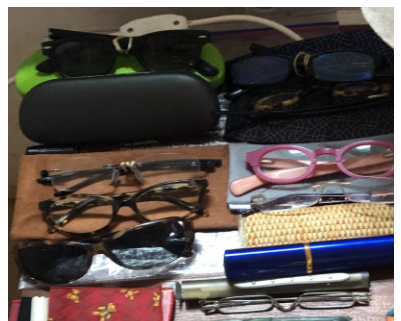
# **Charity Golf Day**

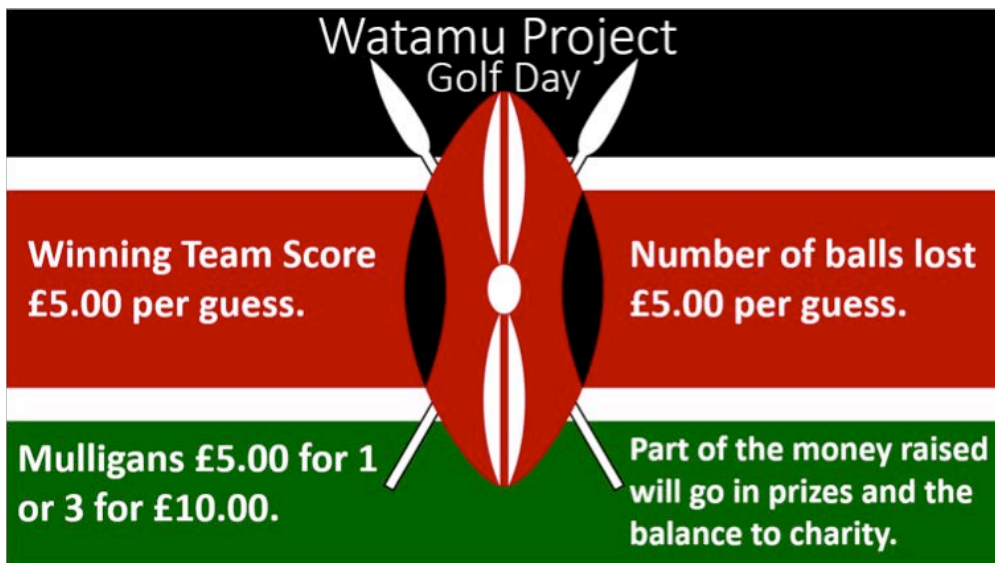

Eco World now employ several hundred local people whose daily wage is 600/= Kenyan Shillings which equates to approximately £3 per day. However, this enables them to feed their families and pay partly towards their children's education.
